W3 Professorship in Neurosurgery as of now

Reference is made to § 61 section 7 Hessisches Hochschulgesetz (HHG) and the conditions of employment based on § 62 HHG. Proficient knowledge of German is expected.

The successful candidate for this professorship will chair the Institute of Neurosurgery. The responsibilities arising from chairing a clinical department, including the associated liquidation rights, will be regulated by a head physician contract.

The applicant should be capable of representing the entire clinical spectrum of neurosurgery. A special interest in vascular and oncological surgery inclusive vertebral column surgery is a requirement, also experiences in neuronavigation and minimally invasive methods.

The successful candidate should be internationally recognised in his/her field of research. He/she should have the ability to demonstrate success in obtaining extramural funding and should demonstrate exceptional skills in teaching, research and patient care, covering all aspects of the field of neurosurgery. The required teaching load will be determined by the medical school ordinances for this discipline.

Cooperation within the existing main research areas of the faculty – cardiopulmonary medicine, infectious diseases, immunology and reproductive medicine – is desired. Participation in the graduate college “Neurosciences” is expected. Participation of the candidate on the Giessen Graduate School for the Life Sciences (GGL) is also desired.
