The Charité is looking for a pathologist with strong interest in morphological aspects of the above mentioned topics and with sound knowledge of advanced methods of immunohistochemistry, murine and human tissue analysis and cell visualization. She/He should be willing to integrate into the above networks and to run a central core facility serving the needs of high-level research and to develop own research fields in this context. She/He should have documented experience in the acquisition and completion of extramurally funded research projects. Participation in clinical diagnostic pathology and in teaching is welcome and subject-matter of negotiations.

Qualifications: as per Berlin Higher Education Act (BerlHG) for W1-position university degree, outstanding thesis (§ 102a BerlHG); for W2-position Junior Professorship or postdoctoral thesis (Habilitation) or equivalent scientific achievement and teaching qualifications (§ 100 BerlHG).

The position is limited to 5 years, but can be extended or converted into a permanent position after positive evaluation.
