Thoracic Transplantation**

The professor should support and develop the existing focus on terminal heart- and lung insufficiency therapy as well as the medical tasks of the leading position.

The establishment and development of clinical and fundamental based research projects on thoracic transplantation, including heart and lung replacement, constitute this profession.

Experience in the area of experimental studies (micro circulation, ischemia/reperfusion) is an advantage. The combined tasks of this profession deal with an interdisciplinary concept, including the heart-thorax-surgery involved clinical partners, as well as the theoretical academics in the sense of translational studies. The willingness to actively integrate into the University heart- and cardiovascular centre and the medical faculty study profile is required. Teaching and studies shall be represented in the area of thoracic transplantation.

Doctorate / M.D./Ph. D. degree or equivalent qualification (§ 36 HG NRW) is required in addition to didactic skills or other comparable scientific achievements, as well as specialist training in cardiac/thoracic surgery.

Profound clinical experience in the field of heart and lung transplantation, application of heart and lung assist devices, and furthermore experience in conventional heart-, lung, and thoracic surgery (incl. minimal-invasive cardiac techniques and endoscopic surgery) is required.

The medical faculty supports the following scientific fields: Heart/Circulation, Oncology, Transplantation and also the comprehensive scientific fields Genetic Medicine and Immunology / Infection.

Professors with medical duties are employed under non-pay scale contracts with basic pay plus performance- and success-based remuneration.

The position shall be occupied as fast as possible.

Deadline for applications:

Date of receipt of the application documents in the medical faculty deanery.
